







## AN INTRODUCTION TO BUILDING AGENTIC SYSTEMS WITH AIINTERACT

The online workshop on 11th January, 2025 at 2:00 PM via Google Meet, led by B Venkatesh from Mira Network, was a success. The session provided hands-on insights into building agentic AI systems, focusing on trustless verification to by improve accuracy counteracting hallucinations and bias. With active participation from 150 professionals and interactive demonstrations, the event met its educational goals and sparked vibrant discussions on AI advancements.









#### PITCH DESIGN STRATEGY

ASHINE, in collaboration with TiE Surat, organized the Pitch Design Strategy Event on 24th January 2025, at SVNIT, Surat. The event focused on storytelling techniques and pitch design strategies to help entrepreneurs craft compelling presentations for investors.

The session featured Pradeep Yuvraj, Founder of Prezantim Academy, Coimbatore, as the keynote speaker. He shared insights on effective storytelling, investor-focused pitch structuring, and strategies to enhance pitch delivery, enabling participants to refine their presentations.

With over 80 participants, the event provided a platform for learning, networking, and skill development. Attendees gained practical knowledge on how to create impactful pitches, enhancing their ability to communicate ideas effectively and attract investment.









#### **DOT.SLASH 8.0 HACKATHON**

DotSlash 8.0, a 30-hour in-person hackathon, was successfully conducted at SVNIT Surat on 1st and 2nd February 2025, organized by ASHINE, supported by SSIP 2.0, and in association with ACM NIT Surat. The event aimed to address real-world challenges in Cyber Security, Artificial Intelligence, Health-Tech, and e-Governance, bringing together some of the brightest minds in innovation. Out of 1,110 registrations, 120 participants across 40 teams were selected for the final round. Expert mentors evaluated based problem projects on identification, feasibility, innovation, and shortlisting 8 teams for the final pitch.

The hackathon concluded with a prize distribution ceremony, recognizing outstanding solutions. The Untitled emerged as the Champion (₹25,000) for developing a market research and financial analysis platform for entrepreneurs. Holy Trinity secured 1st Runnerup (₹15,000) with a streamlined UI for managing government documents (UID, PAN, Passport), while RRR won 2nd Runner-up (₹10,000) for a comprehensive e-Governance solution. The winners were felicitated by Dr. S. R. Patel (Dean of Students Welfare), Dr. H. K. Dave (Professor In-charge, Research Park), Dr. Sankita Patel (ACM Faculty Chairperson), Dr. Rajesh Choudhary (DotSlash & SSIP Coordinator, ASHINE), and Mr. Mayur Kalsariya (Incubation Manager, ASHINE). DotSlash 8.0 successfully fostered innovation, collaboration, and problemsolving, strengthening SVNIT's startup and tech ecosystem.

The event successfully enhanced awareness of IPR, encouraging young innovators to explore the role of intellectual property in building competitive startups and further strengthening South Gujarat's entrepreneurial ecosystem.

#### IGNITION 5.0 - SCREENING FOR PROPOSALS RECIVED FOR PROOF-OF-CONCEPT (POC) DEVELOPMENT UNDER SSIP 2.0

Ignition 6.0 program invited applications from students at the idea level for innovative projects seeking funding to develop a Proof-of-Concept (PoC). Innovators were eligible to receive up to ₹2,50,000 under the Gujarat Government's SSIP 2.0 policy to develop their PoC. A total of 15 applications were received, and 3 projects were approved by the Educational Institutions Level SSIP Scrutiny Committee during the screening on 11th March, 2025. These projects were granted a total of ₹2,93,000 in funding.







#### CATALYST 6.0 AND SECURE 3.0 -SCREENING FOR PROPOSALS FOR STARTUPS UNDER PRE-INCUBATION PROGRAM AND IP SUPPORT

The Catalyst 6.0 Program invited applications from startups seeking support to develop a Proofof-Concept (PoC) from their ideas. Designed to strengthen the pre-incubation pipeline, the program offered selected startups grants of up to ₹2,50,000 under SSIP 2.0 for PoC development. Open to students, startup enthusiasts, and innovators across Gujarat, the initiative attracted 23 startup applications. On 12th March 2025, the Institution-Level SSIP Scrutiny Committee conducted the selection process and shortlisted six startups. These selected startups were awarded additional cumulative funding support of ₹2,70,000 under SSIP 2.0, further accelerating journey toward innovation commercialization.

The Secure 3.0 IP Support Program invited proposals from startups and innovators seeking funding for intellectual property protection under Gujarat Government's SSIP 2.0 policy. Support was available for patents, copyrights, trademarks, international registrations, industrial designs, and more. A total of 5 applications were received, with 3 recommended by the Institution–Level SSIP Scrutiny Committee for further review by the institute's IPR committee.





#### INDUSTRY ACADEMIA INTERFACE

On 20th March 2025, SVNIT's ASHINE Incubation Centre, in association with ChemShastra, hosted a Vyakhyan Lecture Series session featuring Dr. Digish M. Panchal, Head of R&D Synthesis at UPL Ltd. He shared insights on advancements in chemical research, industrial innovation, and the future of R&D. The session covered emerging trends in chemical research, the role of innovation in shaping R&D, and opportunities for research commercialization and industry collaborations.

Students and researchers actively participated, engaging in discussions that bridged academia and industry. The session provided valuable industry perspectives, fostering knowledge exchange and inspiring future research.





#### SENSITIZATION SESSION FOR PHD, M.TECH STUDENTS OF SVNIT

## FDP ON INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The five-day Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Innovation and Entrepreneurship was held from 16th to 20th April 2025 at SVNIT Surat, hosted by ASHINE and organized by AICTE and the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell. The program aimed to equip 46 faculty members from 25 institutions with the knowledge and skills to mentor and promote student-led innovation.

Throughout the FDP, participants engaged in expert-led sessions, hands-on workshops, and exposure visits, covering topics such as the startup journey, innovation ecosystems, startup finance, IPR, and incubation practices. More than 15 domain experts delivered impactful insights. The program began with an inaugural session and concluded with a valedictory ceremony attended by esteemed dignitaries. Faculty members who actively initiated innovation activities at their institutions were awarded a special Certificate of Completion.







## WORKSHOP ON PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION

The first workshop under the ASHINE Pre-Incubation Program was conducted on 19th April, focusing on the theme of Problem Identification. The session was led by Mr. Sunny Kabrawala, Founder of Space Technologies and Rocketry (STAR). A total of 26 innovative startups actively participated in the workshop.

The interactive session empowered 26 participating startups to turn ideas into practical, impactful solutions.

The second workshop of the ASHINE Pre- On 17th May 2025, ASHINE, in collaboration with TiE Surat, conducted the Growth Lab workshop focused on harnessing the power of AI. Led by Bhautik Kumar, the session went beyond theory—delivering practical, actionable insights on smart communication, LinkedIn positioning, and leveraging AI for business growth. Participants left with greater clarity, confidence, and hands-on tools to apply AI The workshop saw
33 founders effectively. saw active participation and entrepreneurs.














#### **INCUBATEE'S MEET**




#### DESIGN THINKING FOR ENTREPRENEURS














#### TIE U SESSION ON BRANDING, STORYTELLING, AND GTM

They shared practical insights with aspiring founders, helping them understand and navigate compliance challenges effectively to ensure their ventures operate smoothly and sustainably.







On 13th September 2025, ASHINE, in ASHINE invited applications from students, innovators, and startups seeking support for developing Proof-of-Concepts (PoCs) and IPR assistance under the SSIP 2.0 program. The initiative aimed to strengthen the pre-incubation pipeline by offering selected startups grants of up to ₹2,50,000 for PoC development, along with support for patents, copyrights, trademarks, international registrations, industrial designs, and more.

> The program received 28 PoC applications and 5 IPR applications from students and startup enthusiasts across Gujarat. On 13th September 2025, the Institution-Level SSIP Scrutiny Committee conducted the selection process and shortlisted 5 startups, including 2 PoC projects. For IPR support, 2 out of the 5 applications were recommended. The selected startups were collectively awarded ₹11,79,000 under SSIP 2.0, providing a substantial boost to advance their innovation and commercialization journey.







## SENSITIZATION SESSION AND FOOD INNOVATION EXHIBITION BY VVWU STUDENTS




## TIE U TECH AND INNOVATION FOR EARLY-STAGE STARTUPS






#### WORKSHOP ON CUSTOMER VALIDATION AND MENTORING SESSION
